Boy Scout Patch Placement For Your Organization! Scouts who aren't in the OA shouldn't have any patch on the correct pocket flap. A scout may also decide not to put on a temporary patch. Some Webelos scouts might have a name patch rather than den numerals. Lastly, in case the Scout earns the Recruiter patch, it ought to be worn directly beneath the proper pocket.

Right Sleeve Cub Scout Patch Placement The American flag is sewn on the right sleeve of the Cub Scout uniform at position 1. If you purchase your uniform new, the flag will be sewn on already. If your uniform is used, the flag may have been removed, but you can buy another one from your Council.

The BSA Insignia Guide discusses all the uniforming, patch placement, and other insignia use. Merit badge placement on the sash is up to the scout. The badges can be displayed in rows of two or three, starting three inches down from the top of the sash. There is no required ordering of badges.

Boy Scout Uniform

• Any National Scout jamboree patches currently stocked by the Boy Scouts of America (BSA) Supply Group should not be reproduced. • All JCSP's must not exceed 3 inches x 5 inches in size in their entirety. Any JCSP that does not conform to this guideline may not be authorized. Troop or crew numerals cannot be embedded in the design.

g GUIDELINES FOR CUSTOM PATCHES AND EMBLEMS

Anyhow, the Insignia Guide is intentionally vague on patch placement so as to give scouts and their troops some latitude. I usually suggest a scout sew the patch from their favorite activity on their right pocket. He/she can then sew patches that reflect his next-favorite activities or achievements on the back of the sash.

Question about patch placement - Scouts BSA Program ...

No more than two jamboree patches may be worn on the shirt—one current national jamboree patch above the right pocket and one current world jamboree patch on the right pocket. If the wearer has an interpreter strip above the pocket, merely move the jamboree emblem upward sufficiently to accommodate it.

GUIDE TO AWARDS AND INSIGNIA - Boy Scouts of America

Boy Scout youth advancement patches may be worn on the Venturing uniform, but they cannot wear both the Boy Scout rank patch and a Venturing Awards patch at the same time. Venturers may also wear the Arrow of Light and Eagle knots if earned. A female Venturer or adult advisor may wear the Girl Scout Gold Award if earned in Girl Scouting.

Left Sleeve. Council shoulder patch is directly below the shoulder seam. Veteran unit bar, if worn, is centered and touching the council shoulder patch (above) and unit numeral (below). Unit numeral, if worn, is centered directly underneath and touching the council patch or veteran unit bar.

Unit number, cloth, green on tan, Nos. 18070 through 18078 (last digit indicates the unit number for 0 through 8); for unit number 9, order No. 10406. Scout and Scout leader, left sleeve, position 2, touching council shoulder emblem if veteran unit bar is not worn.
