verbs like give, find and owe.

There is a second rule that you must remember when direct and indirect pronouns are used in the same sentence. When both the indirect and direct pronouns begin with the letter “I”, you must change the indirect pronoun (which comes first) to “se.”

Indirect pronouns have the function of indirect object. Therefore, they are used when the verb is followed by the preposition “ a ” (to) and they answer the question “To whom? To what?”. For example: Miriana ha telefonato a Luca = Miriana gli ha telefonato (Miriana phoned Luca = Miriana phoned him). In this case, the indirect pronoun gli replaces the indirect object: “a Luca”.

Direct object pronouns are those pronouns that represent the noun directly acted upon by the verb. Indirect object pronouns stand for the noun that is the recipient of the verb's action.

Using Spanish Direct and Indirect Object Pronouns

The direct object is underlined in each sentence, but in the second sentence it has been changed to a direct object pronoun and moved to directly in front of the verb. When there are two verbs in the sentence, the first one is conjugated and the second one is used in its infinitive form.

Indirect object pronouns are somewhat different from direct object pronouns because indirect object pronouns are used even when the actual indirect object is stated. Table 1 lists the indirect object pronouns. As discussed earlier, English pronouns are the same for both indirect and direct objects.

Many people have trouble choosing the correct pronouns for direct and indirect objects. English pronouns that may legally function as objects include me, you, him, her, it, us, them, whom, and whomever. Here are some examples of direct and indirect object pronouns, all in italic: Ticktock *smashed him* right on the nose for suggesting that “the mouse ran down the clock.” (*smashed* is the verb; Ticktock is the subject; *him* is the object)

Direct and Indirect Object Pronouns Used Together ...

Object pronouns replace direct and indirect objects in a sentence. These pronouns help eliminate unnecessary repetition. Here are the English object pronouns used to replace both direct and indirect objects: singular: me, you, him, her, it; plural: us, you, them; Let’s use some examples from the previous section to illustrate how pronouns work.

Direct and Indirect Object Pronouns

- You can put the indirect object pronoun, followed by the direct object pronoun, as two separate words before the verb. - such as, “Te lo voy a dar.” I’m going to give it to you.
- You can attach the indirect object pronoun and the direct object pronoun onto the end of an infinitive. - such as, “Voy a dártelo.”

Indirect Objects and Indirect Object Pronouns

1) No preposition in front of the noun = noun is direct object and can be replaced by a direct object pronoun. 2) The preposition à precedes an animate noun = noun is indirect object and can be replaced by an indirect object pronoun.

When deciding between direct and indirect objects, the general rule is that if the person or thing is preceded by the preposition à or pour,

that person/thing is an indirect object. If it's not preceded by a preposition, it is a direct object. If it's preceded by any other preposition, it can't be replaced by an object pronoun.
