Anglo-European folk medicine was also based on practicality and availability. Remedies were made from sugar, kerosene, whiskey, vinegar, or soda. Medicinal plants such as mullein, used to treat respiratory ailments, were cultivated by pioneer families, who also used plants such as sassafras, willow bark, or yarrow to treat illnesses of the blood and organs.
