The fuel gauge sender is a component that is found in the gas tank of most road going vehicles. The fuel gauge sender, also commonly referred to as the fuel sending unit, is the component responsible for sending the signal that operates the fuel level gauge in the instrument cluster. The fuel sending unit is made up of an arm, float, and a resistor that changes according the position of the float.

Sending Units | West Marine

The sending unit is located in the fuel tank of the car. It consists of a float, usually made of foam, connected to a thin, metal rod. The end of the rod is mounted to a variable resistor. A resistor is an electrical device that resists the flow of electricity. The more resistance there is, the less current will flow.

An oil sending unit, also called an oil pressure sensor or switch, controls the oil indicator light or gauge in a vehicle. The indicator tells the driver of any problems with the oil pressure. Low oil pressure can lead to engine damage, but you can test the sending unit if you believe it isn't accurate. You can ...

Replacing Oil Sending Unit 2003 Chevrolet 6L Silverado

The sending unit is set to turn the switch on when the oil pressure is below a safe level for use. Since the oil pressure is related to the engine revolutions per minute (RPM), this light will come on at low idle speeds and gradually turn off as the RPM increases.

Engine coolant can spray out causing severe burns if the Engine Coolant Temperature (ECT) gauge sending unit is removed from a hot engine without allowing the engine to cool below 100°F (37°C) and draining the engine coolant into a sealable container first.

How to Test an Oil Sending Unit | It Still Runs

The oil pressure sending unit relays the oil pressure in the engine to the instrument cluster. The unit will illuminate the OIL PRESSURE light if the oil pressure drops below 2psi (13 pa). The sending unit is located on the side of the intake camshaft housing on the 2.4L engine.

The temperature sending unit, more properly known as a temperature sensor, is one of the most important sensors in your car. It is the sensor that tells the computer when the engine has warmed up sufficiently for the computer to pay attention to the many other sensors on the engine and exhaust.

This is actually an oil pressure sender, not a fuel pump. Amazon tried to fix this description and only did it on the sales end, not in the reviews. This sender is terrific - I had a malfunctioning unit and replaced it with a parts store "Select" brand, which turned out to be junk.
