Unlike flatworms that are primarily hermaphroditic, roundworms have hermaphroditic and gender-specific species, with sexual reproduction being the dominant mode of procreation. With gender-specific roundworms, copulation occurs between the male and female; whereas hermaphroditic roundworms self-fertilize their eggs.
