A food bank, food shelf or onsite feeding location may accept food products directly from a grower. Products of the farm may include produce, meats, poultry, shell eggs, grains, dry beans, and honey. The grower can either produce food on their own land to sell without a food license, or they can buy produce and resell it, with a food license.
