Unlike these, the City University of New York (CUNY) Assessment test evaluates the ability and aptitude to learn. The CUNY assessment, which consists of reading, writing and math, evaluates your readiness for taking credit-bearing courses. Students who do not pass the CUNY test are required to take non-credit courses in the area of deficiency.

The CUNY Assessment Test in Mathematics is an un-timed, multiple choice, computer based examination in two sections: Elementary Algebra (Math 5), used to satisfy CUNY's college readiness requirement, and College Level Mathematics (Math 6), used for placement into advanced college-level classes.

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CUNY Assessment Tests (CAT) - Office of Admissions

The City University of New York (CUNY) requires all students to demonstrate proficiency in English (reading and writing) and math in order to enroll in credit-bearing courses in the associated subject. Students may establish proficiency in a variety of ways, including, but not limited to, meeting benchmark scores on the SAT, ACT, and New York State Regents exams.
