Learning styles refer to a range of competing and contested theories that aim to account for differences in individuals' learning. The many theories share the proposition that humans can be classified according to their 'style' of learning, but differ in how the proposed styles should

be defined, categorized and assessed.: 8 A common concept is that individuals differ in how they learn.

During the second half of the 20th century, a large number of psychological theories of intellectual styles were developed. The term intellectual



styles is an umbrella term proposed by Zhang and Sternberg to unify 10 theoretical frameworks of style, and it is gaining increasing use as an encompassing term for theories of cognitive, personality, learning, teaching and thinking styles, etc.
