The IMDG Code was adopted by the IMO's Maritime Safety Committee by resolution MSC.122(75), which sets

out in detail the mandatory requirements for the safe carriage of dangerous goods and harmful substances in packaged form. The Code became largely mandatory in 2004 when it was incorporated by reference within SOLAS.
