On the ukulele this is very easy to do – just move all of the notes up by one fret. If the same tune is moved up a second fret, then the new key is D Major. So any piece of music can be moved to a different key, simple by moving all the notes by the same number of semitones. Musicians call this transposing the music.

Claudio's Ukulele: Ukulele Chord Theory

The b means to flat the note – or lower – the pitch by a half step (one fret). The # means to sharp the note – or raise – the pitch by a half step (one fret). Apply them to the scale degree where they occur. For instance, the formula for a minor chord is: 1 b3 5.

MUSIC THEORY - Dr. Uke

When you fret a string on the uke you shorten the length of the string which changes the way it vibrates and makes it sound higher. Knowing this and that moving up each fret moves you up a "half step" in the notes scale, by knowing your open strings are tuned GCEA, you should be able to work out any note on the neck.
