Nobuyoshi Araki was born in Tokyo in 1940 and given a camera by his father at the ripe age of twelve. He studied photography and film at Chiba University and went into commercial photography soon after graduating. In 1970 he created his famous Xeroxed Photo Albums, which he produced in limited editions and sent to friends, art critics, and people selected randomly from the telephone book.
