In Brazil, 1969, a university professor, Paulo Freire (1921-1997), proposed a revolutionary educational theory: Pedagogy of the Oppressed. Freire suffered eight years of extreme poverty, a consequence of the 1929 crisis that struck North-East Brazil. Suffering extreme poverty as a child had a noticeable effect on Freire's intellectual work.
