**The Male Reproductive System**

Those in the extremities, such as the fingertips, are invisibly small. All parts of the nervous system are protected in some way: the brain by the skull and several layers of sheathing, the spinal cord by the vertebrae, and the peripheral nerves by layers of sheathing. The bony protection of the spinal cord is vital.
