If more solute is added and it does not dissolve, then the original solution was saturated. If the added solute dissolves, then the original solution was unsaturated. A solution that has been allowed to reach equilibrium but which has extra undissolved solute at the bottom of the container must be saturated.

Understand what saturated and unsaturated solutions are ...

A solution with the maximum possible amount of solute is saturated. If a solution contains less than the maximum amount of solute, it is unsaturated. When a solution is saturated and excess solute is present, the rate of dissolution is exactly equal to the rate of crystallization (Figure 13.2. 1 b).

An unsaturated solution is a solution that contains less than the maximum amount of solute that is capable of being dissolved. Figure below illustrates the above process and shows the distinction between unsaturated and saturated. When 30.0 g of NaCl is added to 100 ml of water, it all dissolves, forming an unsaturated solution.
