Codification. On the European continent a movement toward the codification of all law gained considerable strength during the 19th century. In England the principal advocate of codification was Jeremy Bentham, who regarded it as a remedy for what he considered to be the evils

of the common law.

### **Fordham Law Review**

Civil law jurisdictions rely, by definition, on codification. A notable early example were the Statutes of Lithuania, in the 16th century. The movement towards codification gained momentum during the Enlightenment, and was implemented in several

European countries during the late 18th century (see civil code). However, it only became widespread after the enactment of the French Napoleonic Code
